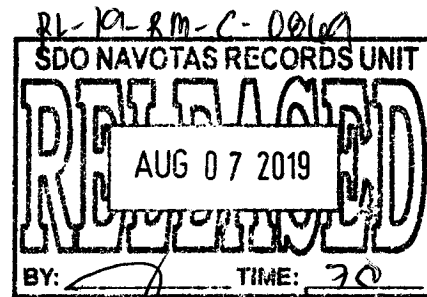

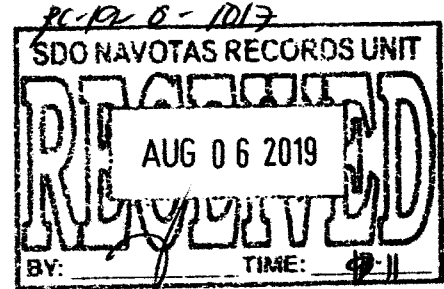

Save the Children has been developing training manuals to capacitate early childhood workforce on child rights-based, developmentally-appropriate teaching methodologies and effective instruction. Part of these materials is the **Gender Equality Toolkit for Early Childhood Educators** to promote gender equality and gender transformative practices among ECCD teachers and facilitators who interact with children in their most formative years. With this training, we are helping set the foundation for gender equality in school, and hopefully in society. This is a first of its kind in the professional development of teachers in the Philippines.

Selected partner schools from your division office will participate in the pilot of the toolkit. As agreed upon in our consultation meeting last May 22, 2019, the Kinder Supervisors (or their representatives) will conduct interview and classroom observations of selected teachers to gather baseline data using the Gender Equality Checklist.
